

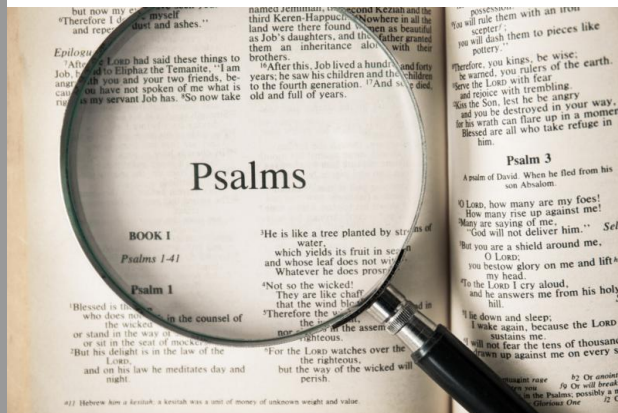

Congregational Meeting

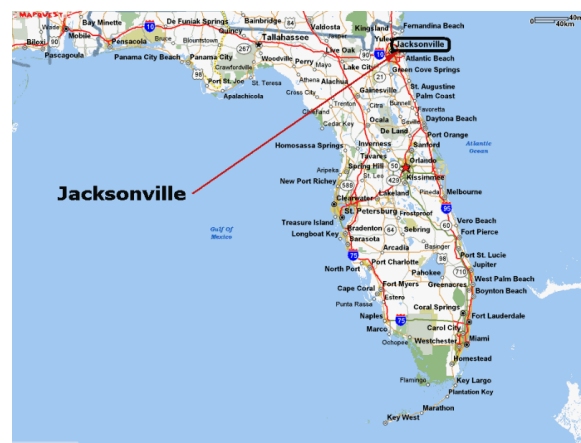
Sunday, June 12

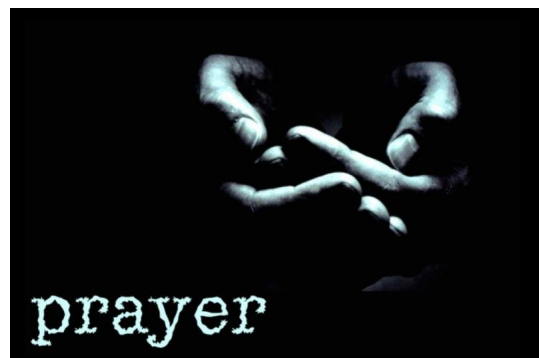

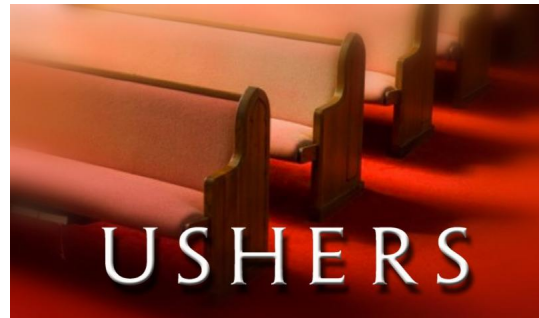
