


Children's Ministry News



Once again, finding the appropriate words seem so impossible as none are adequate. Words like “thank you”, “appreciation”, and “grateful” fall short of conveying the depth of my emotion. You all have literally walked Jimmy’s cancer journey with us from the very first steps through the final ones. Not once was there a pause or decline in your support. We have seen the face of God in the love you have poured over us and it nurtured our walk with Him. We have witnessed first hand the work of Jesus in every call, card, meal, text, visit, flower arrangement, and acts of assistance no matter how large or how



mundane. You literally are the living, breathing body of Christ. Our lives are forever changed by cancer, but even more importantly, by the congregation of John Knox.

Jimmy was so worried about leaving me and I promised him with complete confidence that you would continue to carry me until I had the strength to walk on my own. I know you will hold my hand as I become accustomed to this new chapter. You are already confirming that promise and are such a comfort in ways you cannot fathom. There is a hole in our hearts but we know with assurance that cancer might have killed the body but never can it touch the spirit. I would be willing to bet that Jimmy has picked out a huge section of the banquet table in heaven and staked a "JKPC" sign in the middle of it. He will be waiting there for us.
