Vacation Bible School – Rolling River Rampage!

The deadline for registering for Vacation Bible School is almost here! Registration is due by June 3! Join us as we experience the ride of a lifetime with God through storytelling, crafts, recreation, science, and music. The dates are Sunday, June 24 through Wednesday, June 27. Children who have completed K4 through 5th grade are welcome, and there is no registration fee!

We will kick off our week on Sunday, June 24 with activities for the children from 3:30 – 6:00, followed by a family dinner at 6:00. *Dinner reservations are required*, and can be made on your registration form. There will be suggested meal donations of \$6 per adult and \$4 per child with a \$15 family maximum. Donation baskets will be available that night. Monday through Wednesday, VBS activities for the children will take place between 5:00 – 7:30, with dinner served to the children during this time each night.
