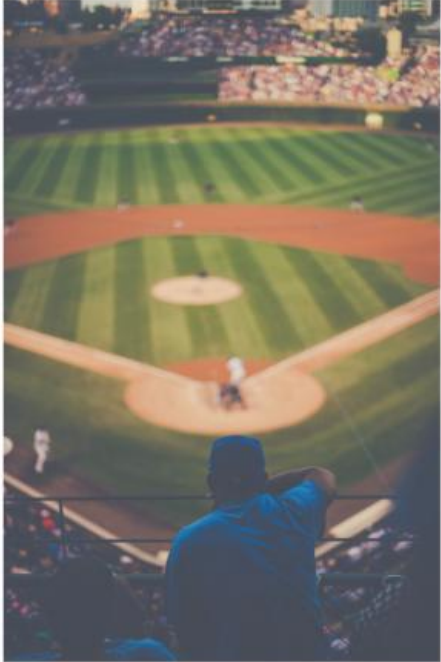

Sr. High Mission Team Update!

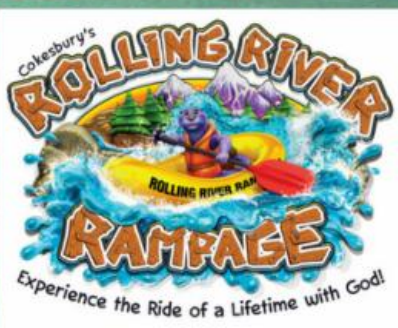

Thank you to all church members and VBS families for sending in donations for Safe Harbor and United Ministries!



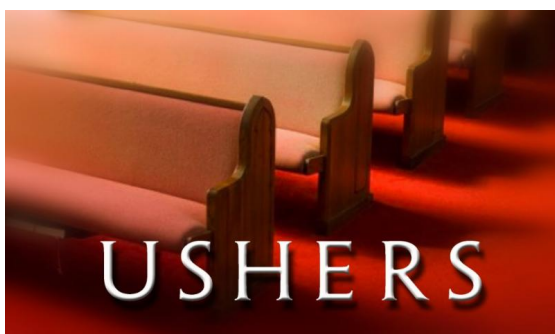
UNITED MINISTRIES FOOD BANK
