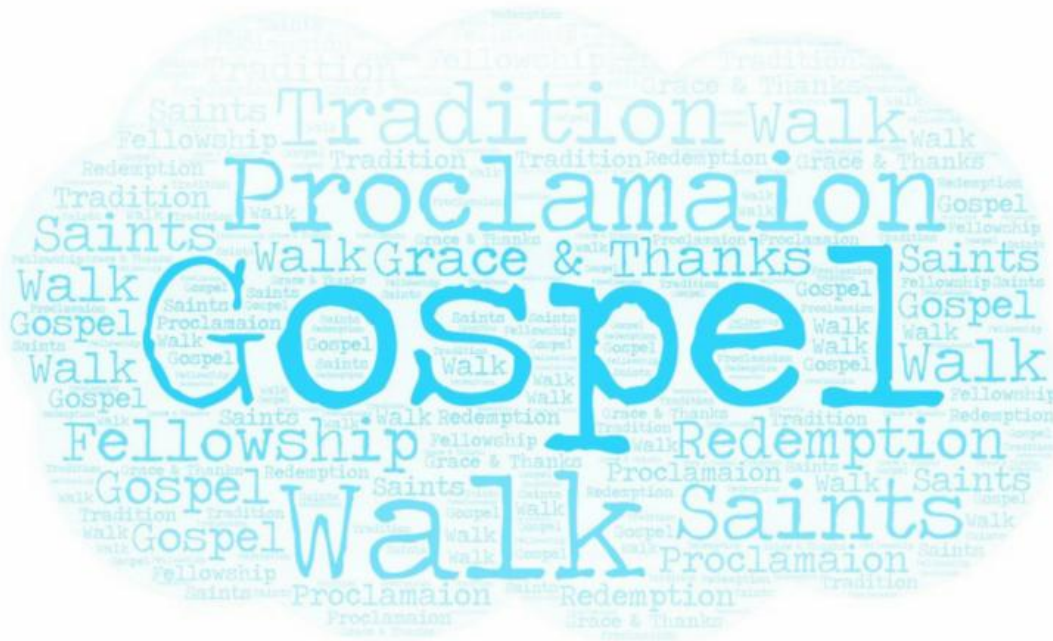

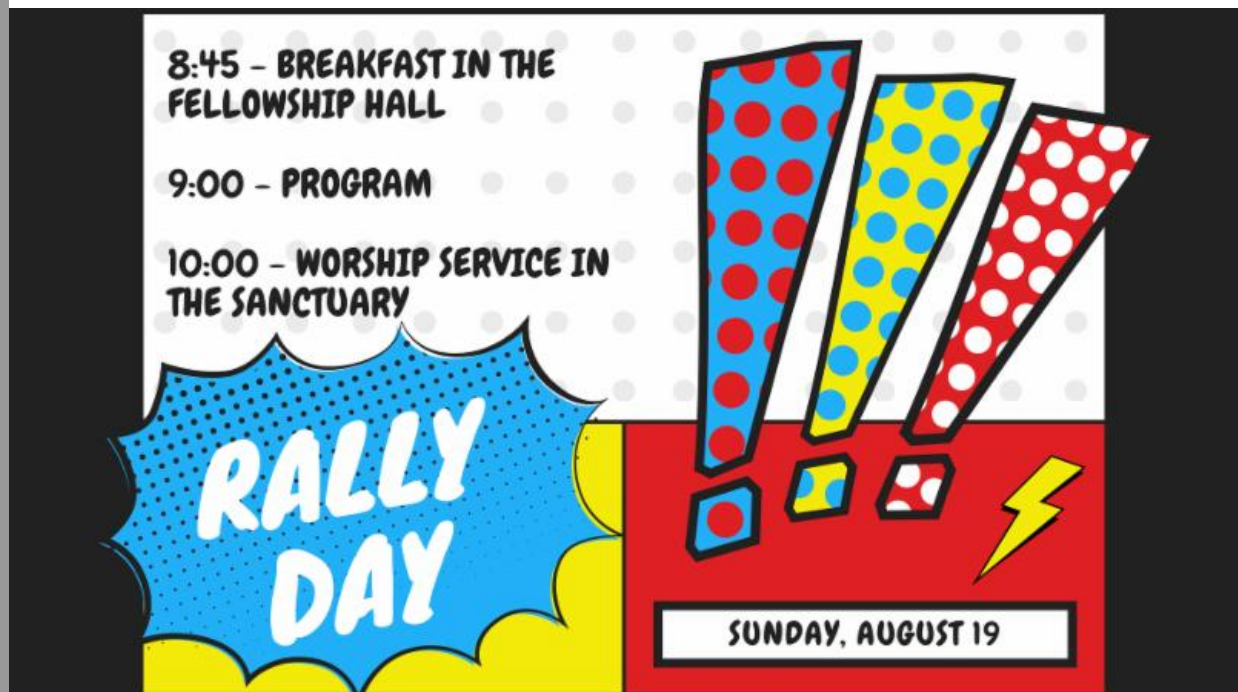

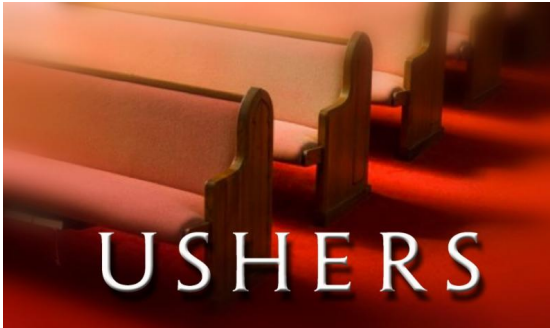


Children's Ministry News
