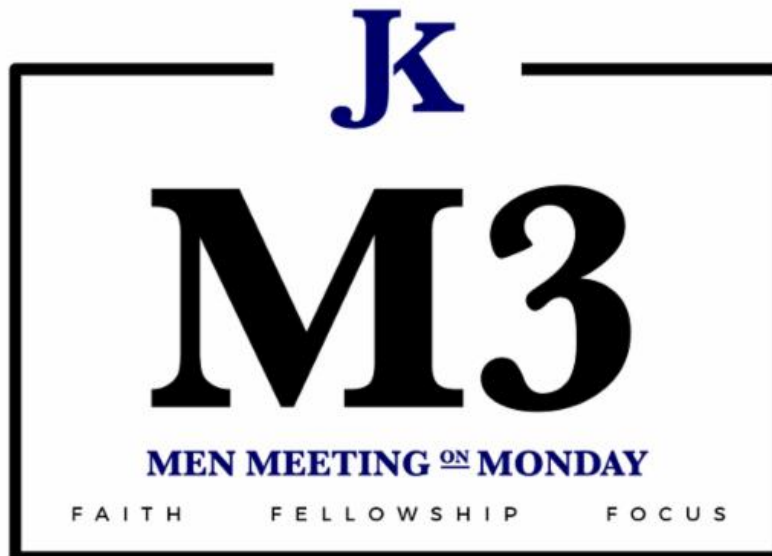

Menu: chicken lasagna, salad bar, garlic rolls, dessert



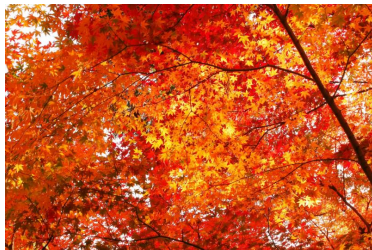
